



Annual Tax Filing Deadline Changing From January 31 to April 30

Beginning with the year 2020, the deadline for annual business tax filers changes to April 30, 2021. This means that business owners who are annual filers will not need to complete a City of Seattle business tax return by January 31, 2021, but instead must complete one by April 30, 2021.

The deadline change applies to the general business and occupation (B&O) tax and other City of Seattle business taxes on gambling, commercial parking, utilities, admissions, etc.

This change gives business owners more time to gather information and complete tax returns, and it brings the City of Seattle into compliance with Washington State law. Mark your calendar with the new deadline and register your business for online management of licensing and taxes on [FileLocal](#).

Please note that although the due date has changed, the tax threshold has not changed. If your business has annual taxable revenue of less than \$100,000 or if your business has no activity for the current year, you will not owe any B&O tax. You are still required to report your revenue, even if it is zero, by filing a tax return with the City of Seattle.
