Staff from the Seattle Department of Neighborhoods manage Community Liaison projects in partnership with staff from other City departments. Their work includes:

- Help you navigate City government to get the information you are trying to find.
- Connect you and your community group with others that have common interests or concerns.
- Help groups in your neighborhood involve and engage ALL community members, especially those voices not at the table.
- Facilitate discussions in your community to help neighbors problem-solve issues or brainstorm opportunities.
- Connect City departments and the Mayor's Office with specific communities to share information and hear concerns.
- Share resources that the City or local organizations have to offer.
