Directions to Woodland Park Zoo's West Entry, 5500 Phinney Ave. N

Driving:

From the South/Downtown: Take 1-5 north to NE 50th Street (Exit #169). Go west to Phinney Ave. N, turn right and drive north to 5500 Phinney Ave.

From the North: Take I-5 south to NE 50th Street (Exit #169). Go west to Phinney Ave. N, turn right and drive north to 5500 Phinney Ave.

By Bus:

From the Downtown/South: Take Metro Transit #5 north from 3rd Ave. and Pine Street to the zoo's West Entrance at N. 55th Street and Phinney Ave. N.

From Ballard/University District: Take Metro Transit #44 east from Ballard Ave. NW toward Montlake. Exit at the intersection of North 46th Street and Phinney Ave. You may either transfer to the #5 bus which stops near the zoo's West Entrance (North 55th Street and Phinney Ave. N) or walk approximately .44 miles to the West Entrance.

By Bike:

Bike racks are provided at each zoo entrance and Phinney Ave. N has bike lanes for your safety. Visit the City of Seattle's site for local bike routes.

Parking:

The zoo has five parking lots, with two on the west side:

- West entrance ("Water Tower lot") at the intersection of N. 50th St. and Phinney Ave N.
- West Entrance at Phinney Ave. N and N. 55th St.
